General Conditions of Transport of the UZH Transport Service

- We transport your goods within the city limits of Zurich and to sites in Schlieren, Dübendorf and Buchs ZH.
- Transports must be requested at least 48 hours in advance by filling out the
 relevant transport order form online. We will confirm the receipt of your
 transport request by email. A surcharge of CHF 100 applies to additional
 transport runs and express transports (requests made less than 48 hours in
 advance). Should additional transport runs become necessary (e.g. as a
 result of missing nitrogen containers), these journeys will be charged at a
 standard amount of CHF 100.
- Max. measurements and load: length 330cm, width 130cm, height 180cm and 850kg.
- A <u>declaration of clearance</u> must be filled in for goods which stem from a biology laboratory with a biosafety level of 2 or higher, or from a chemical or isotope laboratory, or which could be contaminated with biological, chemical or radioactive substances.
- The goods to be transported must include the name of the sender as well as the delivery address.
- The sender is responsible for procuring insurance. For <u>UZH directives</u> on insurance and processing damage claims, please refer to the canton of Zurich's <u>insurance service</u>, including the Government Council resolution from 2003. The canton of Zurich has a framework agreement for transport insurances. Insurance covers transport, temporary storage and exhibitions of procurement materials, including <u>insurance of risks</u>.
- Transport of heavily contaminated goods may be refused by the driver of the Transport Service.
- The goods must be packed in such a way that no damage is possible. Loose items must be sealed in boxes or boxes, including the sender and receiving addresses.
- Transports from ETH Zurich to UZH are only carried out by the ETH Zurich transport service.
- By commissioning the UZH Transport Service, you agree to these General Conditions of Transport.
